

## HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT OF POLICY

The company has appointed a Board Director Mr A Coulson to ensure highest commitment and implementation of company health and safety policy. His duties are set out in the policy document.

The company recognises the important contribution of all its employees and as such accepts that it is the joint responsibility of management and all its employees to achieve proper implementation of this policy. Individual duties are therefore set out clearly.

In acknowledgement of its responsibilities towards health, safety and welfare, the company has appointed Bestsafe Ltd – Health and Safety services as its competent safety consultant to advise and assist.

This policy statement of the company will be displayed prominently on all its sites and workplaces, and will be made available (on request) to any employee, its subcontractor, or other persons in connection with its activities. The policy will be reviewed annually and always updated within two years.
